

## Southern 50 Challenge serves up a walking feast

The green light shone for this year's Southern 50 to go ahead at exactly the right time. A total of 76 teams from across sixteen different Scouting counties registered to take part. Half of the teams were from GLN with all four Districts being represented,

and wow, didn't they do well!





Princes Risborough School, nestling in the heart of the Chiltern Hills, was the chosen start and finish for this year's event, and this was where nearly 300 participants arrived to enjoy a walk in the countryside and challenge themselves. They had the choice of three routes, the 30km distance for Explorer Scouts only, or the 50km or 50 miles routes which were open to all. Weather conditions proved to be more favourable than in previous years. There was no repeat of ice, snow or vicious storms from previous years. Without having an event taking place last year for the first time in 42 years, this produced a total of 68% of participants being novices for their chosen routes, so for many of them, this was a trip into the unknown. This year's route followed paths through the delightful villages of Naphill, Cadmore End, Turville, Maidensgrove, Stoke Row, Christmas Common,







Ibstone and Stokenchurch before heading back to Princes Risborough, with an excellent 90% individual finishing rate. The first two team places in the 30km event was fought out between Phoenix Flyers Young Leaders from 201<sup>st</sup> Islington who finished over an hour ahead of 22<sup>nd</sup> Southgate Young Leaders. Completing the placings was a team from 7<sup>th</sup> Purley, a Group which had been coming along to this event for the past thirty years. Our friends from 20<sup>th</sup> Torbay (picking up the Novice trophy), Luton Hydra ESU, Nomads ESU in Brent and Hitchhikers ESU from Cambridge were not far behind.



The 50km event was won by three Leaders from 8<sup>th</sup> Muswell Hill who had been winners in 2019 and runners-up in the 50 miles the previous year. They finished half an hour ahead of Team Hellfire Originals from West Warwickshire, the most northerly team taking part this year. Hot on their heels were Leaders from Genesis ESU in Basildon, ahead of the Basildon Active Support Unit, then a local Group of Leaders from 1<sup>st</sup> Aston Clinton (picking up the Martin Hornsby Tankard, presented to the fastest team whose average age is 50 years per walker), and then a team of novices from Dionysus ESU based in Billericay & Wickford in Essex (picking up the Chairman's Cup, presented to the fastest team who are all under the age of 25 years). Then came the Potters Bar Plodders and the Phoenix Flyers Ladies (picking up The County Trophy, presented to

the fastest GLN team not picking up any other trophy). One of The Hatters ESU Teams won the 50km Novice Trophy, and another Hatters team collected The Ricky Bickley Memorial Award, presented to the fastest team with all walkers under 18 years not winning any other trophy.



The 50 miles event produced some remarkable stories this year. Four of the eight teams which started, successfully completed as complete teams. In fourth place was a delightful team of 17 and 18 year olds from Merlin ESU in Barnet Borough. They first appeared on the scene in 2019 when they finished 12<sup>th</sup> in the 30km event. The following year, they moved up in class and finished the 50km event in 26<sup>th</sup> position. This year, all eyes were on the ultimate challenge, the unforgiving 50 miles event. They kept going through the whole of Saturday and into the night, crossing the finishing line in a time of 22-30 at 04:30 on Sunday morning. They picked up the Chief's Cup, the first under 25 team, to remind them of their efforts.

Moving into third place, some six hours ahead, were more old friends, Ten Gallon Dixie from Didcot ESU in Oxfordshire, who regularly either come first or second. They were presented with the Grove Trophy for being the fastest team whose average age is 33 years per walker. The runners-up award this year went to Phoenix Flyers, comprising Mark Thompson and daughter Gemma, two 201st Islington Leaders, who added two spare walkers, Martin Kjollesdal-Creasey, a Leader from 14th Southgate and David Liddle, a Leader in Greater London South.







Finally, a fanfare for this year's 50 mile winning team, the 22<sup>nd</sup> Southgate, comprising Tom Nagle, Leader at 22<sup>nd</sup> Southgate, Paul Coleman, Leader at 6<sup>th</sup> Southgate, and Joseph Moulton, a former 22<sup>nd</sup> Southgate Scout and now a members of The Hatters ESU. Tom said that winning the fifty miles event at the Southern 50 had been one of his lifelong ambitions. But Tom's master stroke was to recruit Joseph as the third member of his team just a week before the event, after Joseph had originally been down to walk in the 30km event. Joseph saw that this was an opportunity not to be missed and created history by becoming the youngest ever member of a winning 50 mile team in the entire history of the event.



A massive Thank You to the 100 adults who rose to the occasion yet again to support and ensure that this year's Southern 50 Challenge was a huge success.
